A. Video Laryngoscopy

Several "new and newer" video laryngoscopes will be presented with an opportunity to compare the advantages and disadvantages of each. The uninitiated can find out why, where and how to begin. The experienced operator can share tips and techniques or pose questions about challenging situations.

B. Experience is not enough-(how to avoid common aseptic breaches observed in novice and expert operators during epidural catheter insertion)

This workshop will demonstrate common mistakes in aseptic technique through video demonstration and hands on practice. At the end of this session, participants will be able to detect breaches in sterility and demonstrate proper aseptic technique during epidural catheter insertion

C. Ultrasound for Labor Epidural

- 1. Describe the basics of ultrasound imaging and interpretation of sonoanatomy of the lumbar spine.*
- 2. Describe the ultrasound image patterns in different scanning planes and discuss their applications in facilitating spinal and epidural techniques.*
- 3. Describe the abnormal sonoanatomy patterns and identify relevant structures in obese patients and or those with spine abnormalities.*
- 4. Discuss the potential impact of this technique in the quality and safety of neuraxial blocks.*
- 5. Experience the hands-on training on lumbar spine ultrasound scanning on volunteers.*

D .Ultrasound Guided Peripheral Nerve Blocks

The main objectives of the workshop is to learn basic ultrasound guided upper and lower limb blocks: machine setting up, machine orientation, basic imaging skills and tips.
