- Include a hypothesis and purpose, methods, results and conclusions
- First author must be a trainee (graduate student or postdoctoral fellow)
- Indicate the following in the top of the page:
  - Abstract title
  - List all authors
  - Affiliation (hospital, institution, university)
- Submit in Word or as an email attachment to [alem@uhnres.utoronto.ca](mailto:alem@uhnres.utoronto.ca)
- **Abstract deadline is October 29, 2010**
