

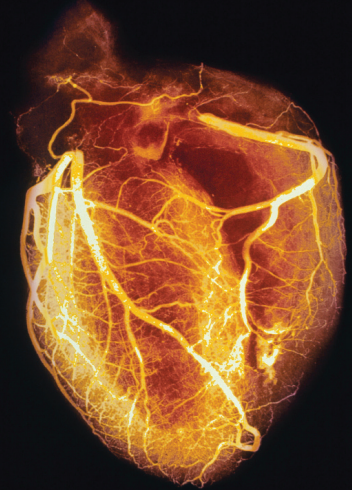

Did you know...

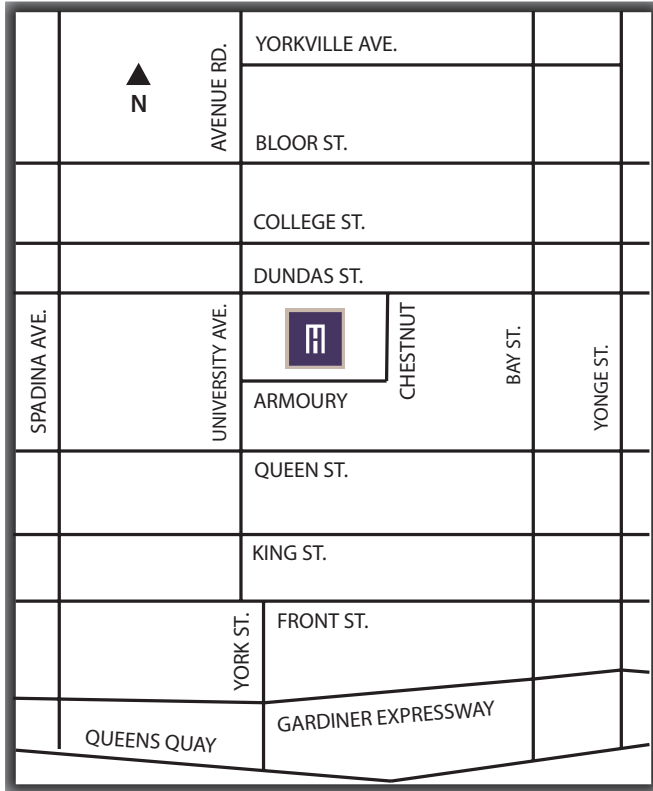
- that heart disease is the **number one killer** of men over 45 and women over 55?
