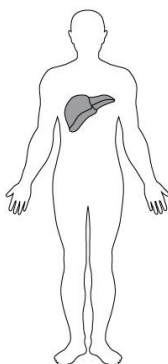

- We have staff that speak different languages and can also arrange translation services if needed

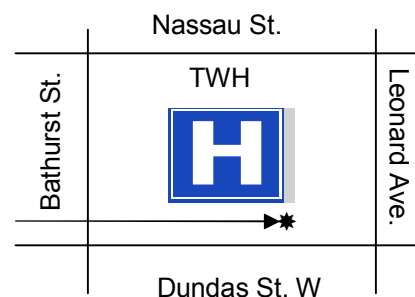
Why Should You Want To Learn About Your Disease?

How To Find Us

By subway: Exit at Bathurst station on the Bloor line and take the Bathurst streetcar south to Dundas Street West.

By car from the north: Take the Don Valley Expressway. Exit at Spadina Avenue and travel northbound to Dundas Street. Turn west and drive until Bathurst Street.

By car from the south: Take the Gardiner Expressway, exit on Spadina Avenue and travel northbound to Dundas Street. Turn west and drive until you reach Bathurst Street.

Parking is available in the Nassau St. lot and on the 1st floor of the Leonard St. lot (entrance is from Nassau St.)
