- The Toronto Western Hospital Tuberculosis Clinic was established in September 2000. We assess and treat clients with both Active Tuberculosis Disease and Latent TB Infection. Our goal is to provide patient-centred, state of the art tuberculosis care to Toronto's multicultural community.
- Consultation and/or referral services are available for any health care provider managing Active or Latent TB in the GTA.
- Multidisciplinary team: includes four Infectious Disease specialists, a Respiriologist, a Primary Care Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Clinician, Public Health Nurse, Social Worker and Respiratory Therapists.
- Diagnostic tests such as Sputum Induction (for sputum cultures) X-rays, CT scans, MRI and blood work are available on site.

TO MAKE A REFERRAL:

Clients need a referral letter from a physician, nurse practitioner or Public Health Department to be seen at the clinic.

- Our physicians do not charge fees to clients with insurance coverage (OHIP, Interim Federal Health, TB-UP, private insurance). However, the hospital and some clinic physicians will charge a fee to uninsured clients visiting the clinic. In addition, the cost of any x-rays, lab tests etc. will be billed to the client.
