

## Cannabinoids (Medical Cannabis) for Osteoarthritis Pain Effectiveness (COPE) Trial

Participants needed for a Research Study (40–80 Hip/Knee osteoarthritis)

### What is this study about?

- Cannabis contains active ingredients like CBD (cannabidiol) and THC (delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol) which may decrease pain and inflammation
- This research study will test if CBD or THC can reduce osteoarthritic pain

### What is involved?

- You will receive capsules containing either CBD, THC, or Placebo (an inactive substance) at no cost
- You will take the study medication for 8 weeks under the guidance of a Study team member
- You will fill out questionnaires online or by phone at:
  - Baseline (~45 minutes)
  - The end of weeks 4 and 8 (~45 minutes each)
  - The end of weeks 1, 2, 3, and 6 (~20 minutes each)
- You will be compensated up to \$140 for completing the trial.
