## **Digital Tools**

#### What is the corporate intranet?

There are many helpful resources located on the UHN corporate intranet that may be useful to you. This is where you will find UHN policies and procedures and interesting stories and news articles. You can access the intranet easily via on-site computers. If you are not on-site then you can access the intranet remotely, you will need your t-ID and password. #### What digital tools do I have access to?

You have access to <u>Microsoft Office365</u>. Log into your <u>O365 portal</u> to begin exploring the online tools, which includes:

- OneDrive for saving and accessing documents from anywhere and any device
- Outlook for accessing your UHN email
- Teams for meetings and teamwork
- Sharepoint for sharing documents with colleagues and other learners
- Office Tools, such as Word, Excel and Powerpoint for creating documents
