Summer Studentship Research Award

Competition is now open!

Application Deadline: April 30, 2025, 5:00 PM EST.

Summer Studentship Dates: June 2<sup>nd</sup> to August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (12 continuous weeks within this period)

Funding Award: \$5,000 for 3 months

<u>Background and Focus</u>: The UHN – Jay and Sari Sonshine Centre in Stroke Prevention and Cerebrovascular Brain Health supports various innovative projects:

- a) In education, quality improvement and clinical practice around brain care and health to improve current stroke prevention initiatives, interventions, programs and models of care that incorporate lifestyle-based education and patient goal-directed approaches; and
- b) In development of strong partnerships with community, public, and global brain health initiatives, to help rapid synthesis, translation, and mobilization of existing knowledge on the relevant subjects.

#### Interested students must meet the following criteria:

- Full-time student enrolled in an undergraduate, postgraduate or health professional degree
  program in a clinical or non-clinical field, (e.g., health sciences, epidemiology, biostatistics, and
  public health students, medical students) or in course-based graduate health sciences and public
  health programs;
- Demonstrated an interest in pursuing a future career in the field of brain health and stroke prevention;
- Able to complete full-time hours for up to a 12-week period; and
- The research project must be related to the JSS Centre's focus as outlined above.

#### **Project Requirements:**

- Projects must be done under the supervision of a UHN Jay and Sari Sonshine Centre's Program member.
- Students are invited to apply, including a brief description of the summer research project and the study proposal developed in conjunction with the supervisor.
- Student will be required to present their research project to the UHN Stroke Program and the JSS Centre's members and colleagues at the end of their summer studentship term.
- While not required, the student will be encouraged to seek opportunities to prepare and submit an abstract for presentation(s) and/or a publication.

## All applicants are required to submit the following:

- Application form
- A 1–2-page proposal outlining the research project, developed in conjunction with the supervisor.
  - o The applicant's role in the project must be clearly defined in the proposal
- A letter of support from the proposed supervising JSS member
- 2 academic letters of support
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- Official Academic Transcript
