

This Special International Hepatology Program offers students an opportunity to undertake clinical electives in the Francis Family Liver Clinic within the Toronto Centre for Liver Disease (TCLD). Elective students will actively engage in the management of patients with complex liver disease. Learners will have the opportunity to diagnose and to manage viral hepatitis, alcoholic liver disease, non-alcoholic fatty liver disease, end stage liver disease, portal hypertension and hepatocellular carcinoma. In addition, learners will provide inpatient hepatology consultation for University Health Network (UHN) and Sinai Health System (SHS). Teaching rounds will focus on liver pathology, hepatobiliary physiology and radiology and the latest advances in hepatology research.
