Services

- Expert Care – Our friendly and experienced staff is trained in cancer medicine and will work with your health care team to help you.
- One-on-One Consults with a pharmacist to review your medications. This will help you prevent and manage any drug interactions (harmful mixes of medication).
- Smoking Cessation Services – Pharmacy staff can help you reduce or quit smoking. Ask a pharmacist for more details and to make an appointment.
- Free Delivery of your prescription medication for anywhere in Ontario. This applies only to items not kept in the fridge. Ask a pharmacy team member for details.
- Ongoing Pharmacist Support – If you have any questions or concerns about your medications, call to speak to a pharmacist.
- Compression Stockings – We have specially trained certified fitters and can facilitate health benefits coordination. Ask us about it!



Drug Coverage

Our Medication Reimbursement Specialists help you get:

- The most possible coverage for your medications.
- Reduced co-payments on eligible Ontario Drug Benefit prescriptions.

Pharmacy Process

1. Order or fill your prescription (get medication):

- Come to the Princess Margaret Outpatient Pharmacy, on the main floor.
- Take a number from the Kiosk Ticket machine in the front of the Pharmacy. Wait for your number to be displayed on the TV. It will tell you where to go so a pharmacy staff can help you.
- Bring a list of your medications and supplements to each pharmacy visit. This helps staff check for drug interactions and keep your medical history up-to-date.
- Bring your drug insurance card(s), health card, and government-issued ID.

2. Pick up your prescription:

- Take a number from the Kiosk Ticket machine in front of the Pharmacy. Wait for your number to be displayed on the TV. It will tell you where to go so a pharmacy staff can help you.
- A pharmacist may need to speak with you for medication advice or review. Be ready to wait at least 10 minutes to pick up your medication.

3. Order refills (if needed):

- Call us at 416-946-6593 to refill your prescription using our automated system. You can call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Call 2 business days before using your prescription number, which is found on your medication bottle next to the "Rx".
- If your medication bottle does not say to get refills, speak with a staff member. Allow extra time to contact your doctor.
- For deliveries, please speak with a staff member (deliveries cannot be arranged through the automated system).

When you use Princess Margaret Outpatient Pharmacy to fill your prescriptions (order medication), a portion of the money you pay is used to support patient care at Princess Margaret Cancer Centre.
