

# POST-DOCTORATE RESEARCH FELLOW, JONATHAN AVERY, ON CURRENT AYA RESEARCH

## PROVIDING CARE TO ADOLESCENT AND YOUNG ADULTS WITH ADVANCED CANCER

A diagnosis of advanced cancer can be difficult for anyone, but for adolescents and young adults (AYA) (ages 15-39), it can be especially hard on the individual and on their family. AYA are at a stage of life when they are seeking independence and autonomy and are establishing their own identity and values to develop relationships, careers and families of their own. Advanced cancer at this stage of life disrupts this development completely. As a post-doctoral research fellow in the Department of Supportive Care, the goal of my research is to understand the unique experiences of AYA with advanced cancer. I've learned that AYA often feel "stuck" in life and are unsure how to be a young adult when they are constantly getting life-sustaining cancer treatments and managing treatment related side-effects. Through this research, I am hoping to develop specific resources and approaches for health care delivery so AYA can still live a fulfilling life, even if they have an advanced diagnosis.





### **FUTURE RESEARCH GOALS**

- 1) How to approach palliative care with AYA when palliation is associated with disease progression and dying.
  - 2) Discussing death and dying with the AYA and the family.
  - 3) How to approach one's education and career when there is so much uncertainty around the prognosis.


