If you make a mistake at first, it is not a big deal - what is important is making a change. Together, we can build communities of support and inclusivity!

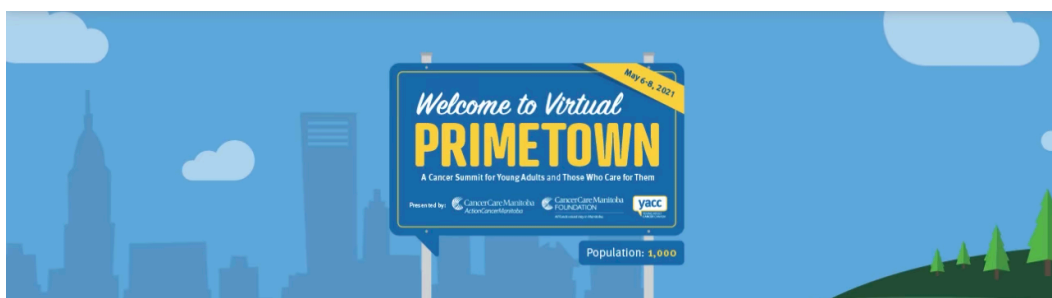
