

Outpatient Acquired Brain Injury Rehab Service: Neuro-Oncology Rehabilitation

What we do:

- We provide interdisciplinary rehabilitation to individuals who have experienced changes in their physical, perceptual, cognitive or communicative abilities as a result of a neuro-oncology diagnosis affecting the brain.
- We offer short-duration intervention (approximately 6 weeks) that may include assessment and treatment, education and consultation.
- Our team includes Physiatrists, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists and Speech Language Pathologists.

Who we serve:

We work with individuals aged 18 or older who have a new neuro-oncology diagnosis, or recurrence, confirmed within the last two years who:

- Have completed radiation treatment, if applicable
- Are mentally, physically and medically stable to participate in regular rehab therapy appointments
- Have not received prior outpatient rehab services for this diagnosis
- Who have rehab goals and the potential to achieve these goals through program participation
- Have reliable transportation to attend in-person appointments, and have a caregiver to accompany them if assistance is required for transfers or wayfinding
