


TR Confusion Assessment Method (CAM) Tip Sheet


CAM is a Two-Step proces:

- 1) Document the **Assessment**.
 - 2) Document the **Interventions**.
- Delirium Prevention and Management must be completed for CAM negative and CAM positive Assessments.
 - These assessments are for IP visits and are located on the **Patient Desktop** within the **Assessments** tab.




Select **CAM (Confusion Assessment Method)**.

Enter the actual time the assessment was completed. Always read the transaction line first for directions.




Select the appropriate Assessment type and then click **OK**.



New fields will generate if certain options are selected.


Once all mandatory fields in the Assessment have been completed, *click Accept*.



TR Delirium Prevention and Management Tip Sheet


Delirium Prevention and Management must be completed for CAM negative and CAM positive Assessments. These assessments are found on the **Patient Desktop** within the **Assessments** tab.

Select Delirium Prevention and Management.


Enter the actual time the assessment was completed.

You can *click* on each option separately and/or *select* a range of numbers with a dash in between, such as 4-6.



Viewing CAM Assessments and Interventions

- **Whiteboard** – If the patient is CAM positive a red “D+” will display
- **Patient Dashboard**-  will display if the patient is CAM positive
- **Patient Shortcuts**

 - All Assessments Report
