
Exercise Myocardial Perfusion Test



Check in at the Nuclear Cardiology desk










The test will be explained to you. You will be asked to sign a consent form for your test.




A technologist will give you an injection of a radioactive tracer to prepare your heart for your rest images.

A wait of approximately one hour will follow your first injection.






Your pictures will take about 25 minutes. It is important to be very still during this time.




You will now begin the stress portion of your test. After being given an intravenous, you will walk on the treadmill.



A technologist will give you a second injection of radioactive tracer into your intravenous while you walk.





Your second set of images will be slightly shorter than your first.
