What is a Tuberculosis (TB) Clinic?

The Toronto Western Hospital Tuberculosis Clinic is a specialized clinic that assesses and treats patients with both Active TB disease and Latent TB infection. Since September 2000 when the clinic opened, the TB Clinic Team has provided the latest comprehensive tuberculosis care to Toronto's multicultural community.

TB can be treated and cured.

What health care professionals are part of the TB Clinic Team?

The TB Clinic Team has:

- 5 doctors (4 Infectious Disease Specialists and a Respiriologist)
- Primary Care Nurse Practitioner
- Nurse Clinician
- Public Health Nurse
- Social Worker
- Respiratory Therapist

What services does the TB Clinic provide?

- All diagnostic tests for TB can be done here in the clinic or hospital.
- Education for patients and their family is provided at all clinic visits. Written information about TB is available in a variety of languages.
- We know that many of our patients need an interpreter. **Please tell clinic staff if you need an interpreter.**
- The Ontario Ministry of Health provides free TB medications to our patients and all standard TB medications are available in the clinic.

Do I have to pay for service?

Our doctors **do not** charge fees to patients with OHIP, Interim Federal Health, or Private Insurance coverage.

For patients without health insurance, the Public Health Department can help. Please ask the TB Clinic Team for more information or contact your Public Health Department TB program.
