## **Nomination Criteria**



Read below for more detail about the Cancer Education Awards criteria. Nominations with impressive examples and clear, convincing descriptions will be awarded more highly than those without clear examples.

### Excellence in Mentorship

The **Excellence in Mentorship Award** recognizes any staff or faculty member of the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre who has acted as a mentor and made a significant impact on the mentee(s). Priority will be given to those mentors with a sustained track record over time, whose mentees are from marginalized or underrepresented groups and those who have mentored individuals in different professions and/or jurisdictions.
