Washing Instructions for Synthetic Wigs

- 1. Gently brush your wig to remove teasing or tangles before washing.
- Add one to two spoonfuls of wig shampoo to cold water (NEVER USE HOTWATER). Gently swish your wig up and down in this water. The number of times you do this will depend on how dirty your wig is. DO NOT RUB your wig.
- 3. After dunking up and down in the water, rinse your wig thoroughly in cold water. Pat out excess water into a soft towel.
- 4. Apply "Leave-in Conditioner" by spraying it very lightly over the entire wig surface. This will stay in your wig until the next wash, and will further condition the fibers of your wig.
- 5. Do not squeeze or twist your wig. Do not brush or comb your wig until it is completely dry.
- 6. Dry your wig at room temperature on your wig stand. DO NOT USE A HAIR DRYER! Never put your wig on a solid head stand or block. This will stretch the cap.
- 7. When your wig is completely dry, it is ready to brush or comb. Do not use a curling iron on your wig.

Caution: Avoid exposing your wig to excess heat, such as opening of ovens, BBQ's, etc. Excess heat will damage your wig.
