Wondering what it takes to become a UHN volunteer?







Requirements

- ✓ Be 16 years of age or older
- ✓ Respect the mission and values of UHN
- ✓ Have an advanced level of English, both speaking and writing
- ✓ Be willing to commit to your placement for at least 6 - 12 months
- ✓ Must be able to contribute at least 2-4 hours once a week
- ✓ Be professional, reliable, punctual, team-oriented, customer-service oriented
- ✓ Must agree to a health screening that includes a two-step TB test
- ✓ Agree to wear a uniform and ID badge during every shift
- ✓ Abide by the confidentiality and volunteer agreements

Qualifications

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills in English
- ✓ Strong problem-solving and conflict-resolution skills
- ✓ Good interpersonal skills, caring and friendly, and able to interact with family and visitors when required
- ✓ Proactive and resourceful
- ✓ Pay attention to detail
- ✓ Must be able to take direction, but also to work independently
- ✓ Accountable, reliable and punctual

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

Things to keep in mind...



to complete the screening process

- ➤ Submitting an application does not guarantee you a volunteer placement at UHN
- The process to become a volunteer has several steps (all of which are important) and may take some time. This intake process was developed in order to best serve the patients and staff, and potential volunteers of UHN.
- ➤ Volunteers are selected and placed according to the needs of the hospital. Interests, skills, availability and suitability are all taken into consideration. Evening and weekend opportunities are limited.
- ➤ Volunteers are here to enhance the patient experience. Volunteer roles have boundaries and do not include any tasks that can only be performed by trained healthcare professionals. Volunteering will not allow you the opportunity to practice or develop your clinical/technical skills, nor will you be able to observe medical treatments or procedures.
- There are areas of the hospital which do not offer volunteering opportunities. If you have a particular area/department in mind, please visit our 'Volunteer Opportunities' or contact our offices to inquire before applying.

What are the benefits?

- Providing volunteers with a space they can call their own. A Volunteer Lounge where they can come, have a coffee, meet other volunteers, and store their personal belongings while on shift
